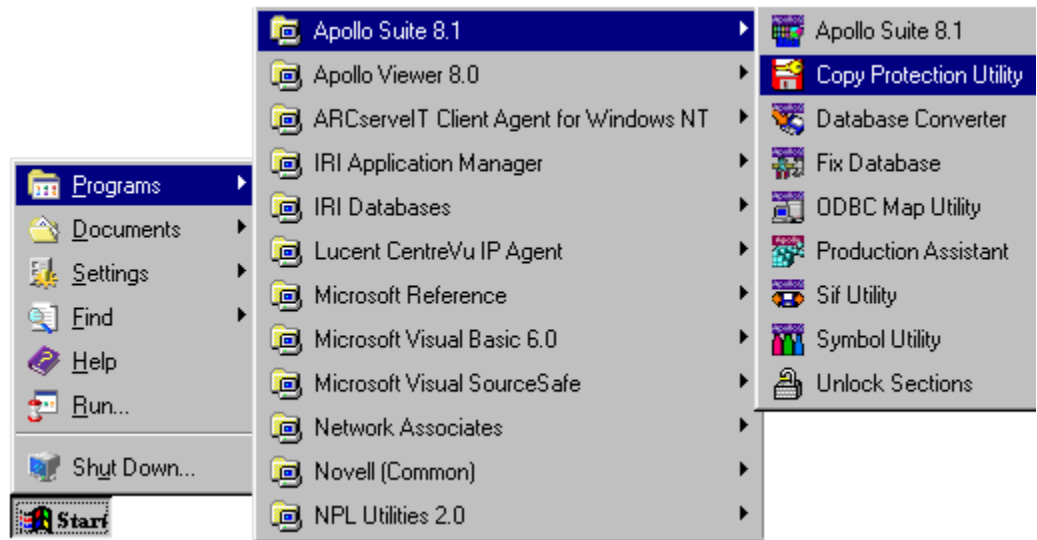


# APOLLO 8.1

## HOW TO USE THE COPY PROTECTION UTILITY

### To run the Copy Protection Utility

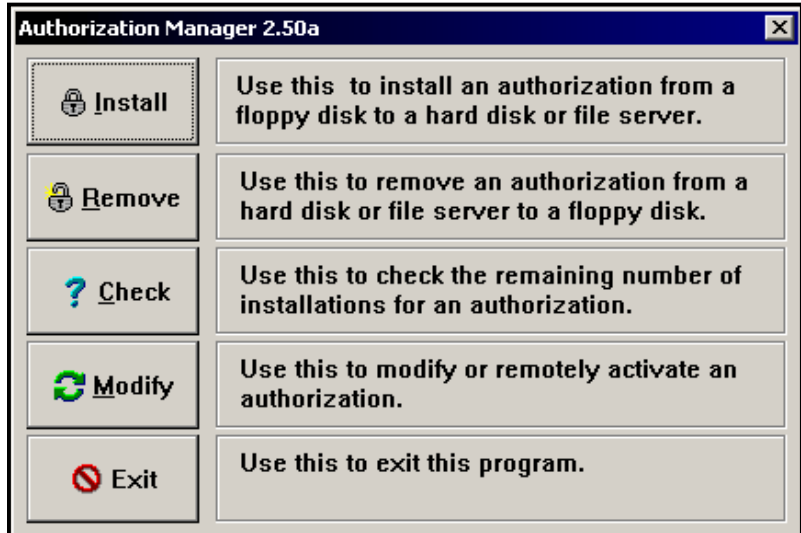
- Click **Start**.
- Select **Programs**.
- Select **Apollo Suite 8.1**.
- Click **Copy Protection Utility**.
- The **Authorization Manager 2.50a** will start.



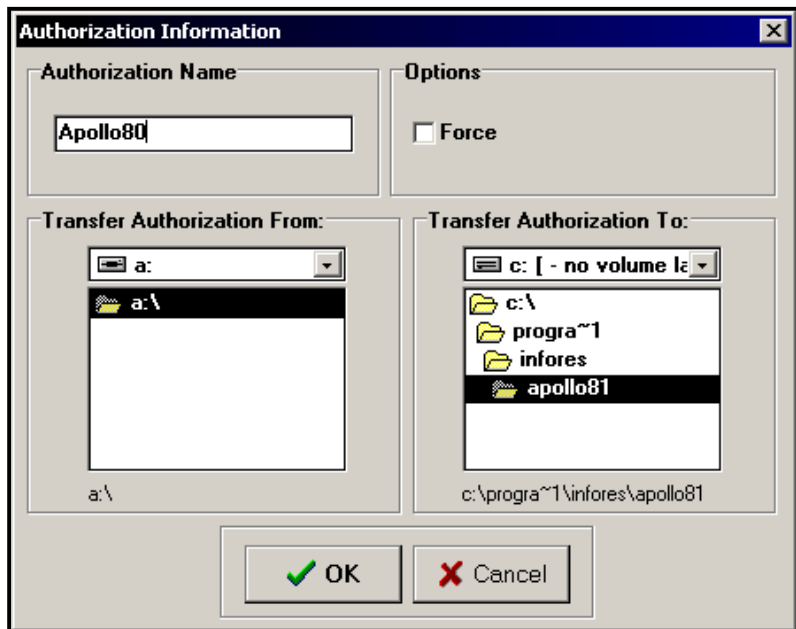

## Install Copy Protection

1. Insert the Copy Protection diskette into the floppy drive.
2. Click **Install** from the Authorization Manager Menu.



3. **Authorization Name:** If the Authorization Name field is blank enter *Apollo80*.

4. **Transfer Authorization From:** This is the floppy drive from which the Copy Protection is coming from. Drop the list box down and select your floppy drive.
  5. **Transfer Authorization To:** Verify the default path to Apollo is correct, if not, drop the list box down to locate the correct path. If all information is correct, click **OK**.

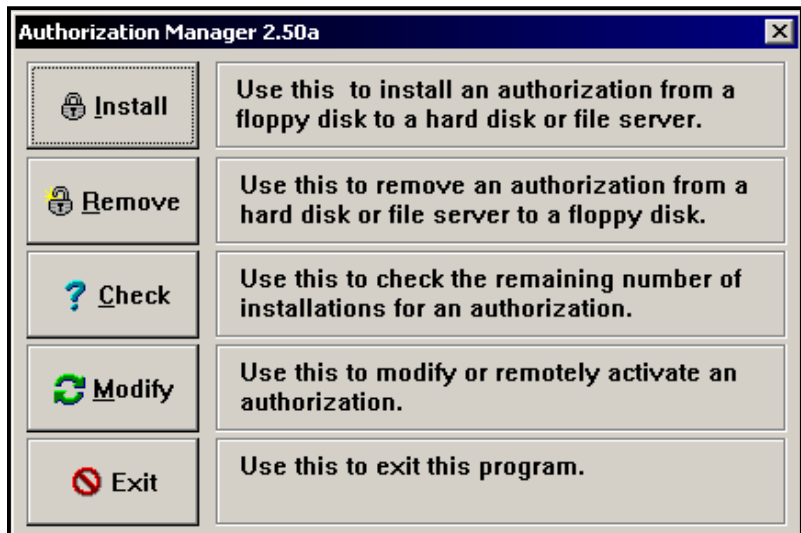
**NOTE:** The default location is  
C:\Program Files\Infores\Apollo81

**NOTE:** Only click **Force** if instructed by an IRI  
Technical Support Representative.

6. After the '**Operation Successful!**' message click **OK**.



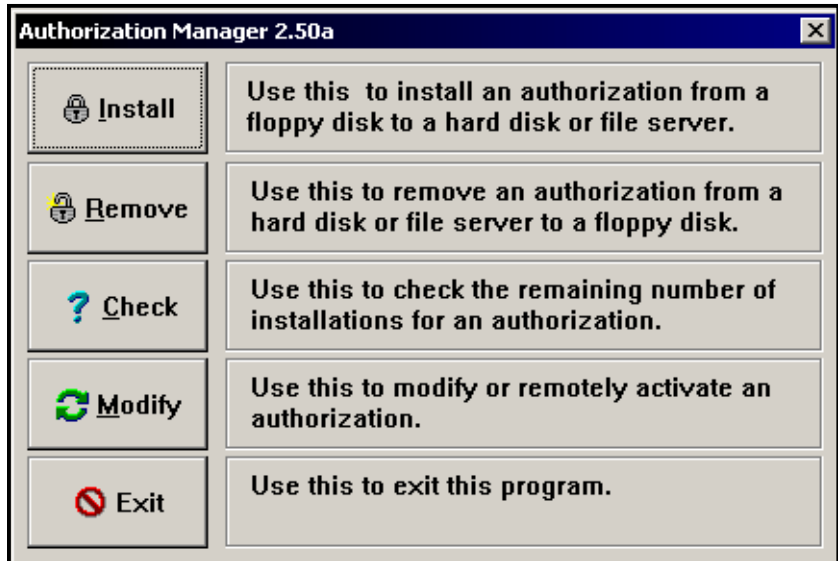
7. The Authorization Manager brings you back to the Menu, if you have no other functions to perform click **Exit**.



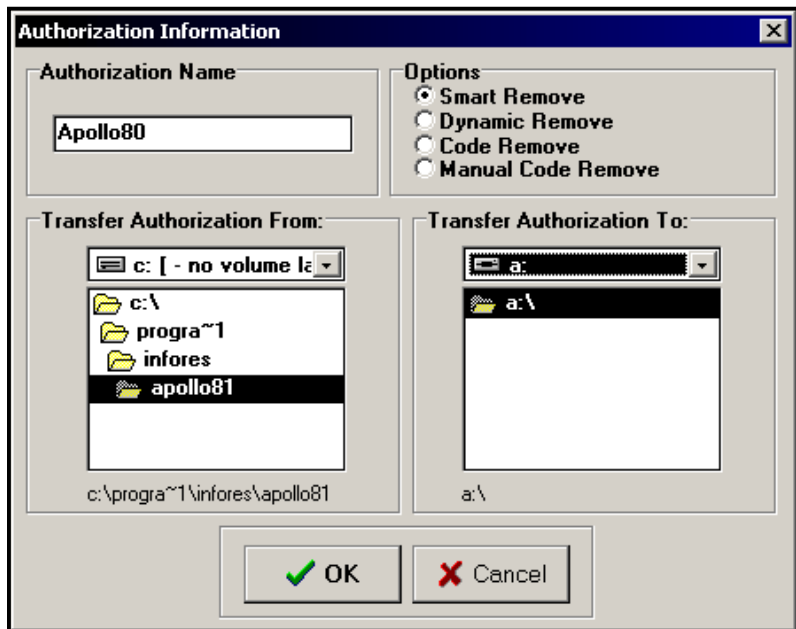

## Remove Copy Protection

1. Insert the Copy Protection diskette into the floppy drive.
2. Click **Remove** from the Authorization Manager Menu.



3. **Authorization Name:**  
If the Authorization Name field is blank enter *Apollo80*.

4. **Transfer Authorization From:** Verify the default path to Apollo is correct, if not drop the list box down to locate the correct path.

**NOTE:** Apollo's default location is *C:\Program Files\Infores\Apollo81*.

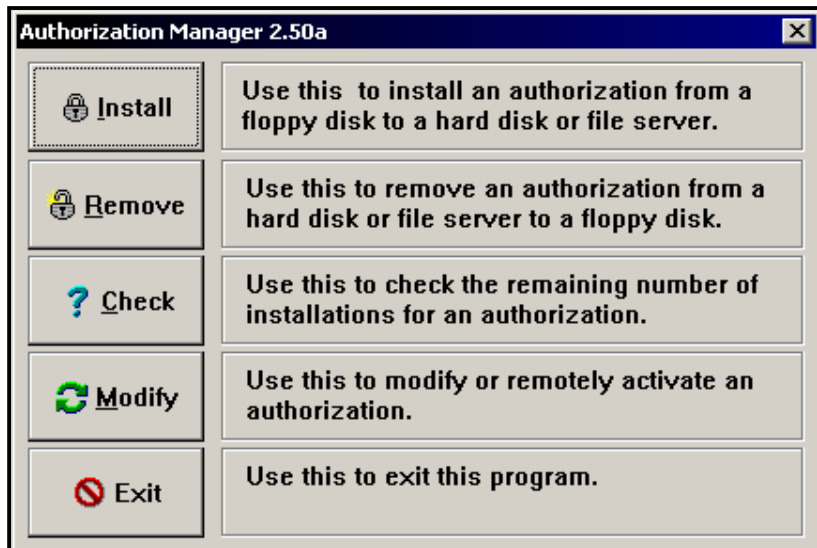
5. **Transfer Authorization To:** This is the floppy drive from which the Copy Protection is going to. Drop the list box down and select your floppy drive. If the information is correct, click **OK**.

**NOTE:** Leave **Smart Remove** checked.

6. After the **Operation Successful!** message click **OK**.



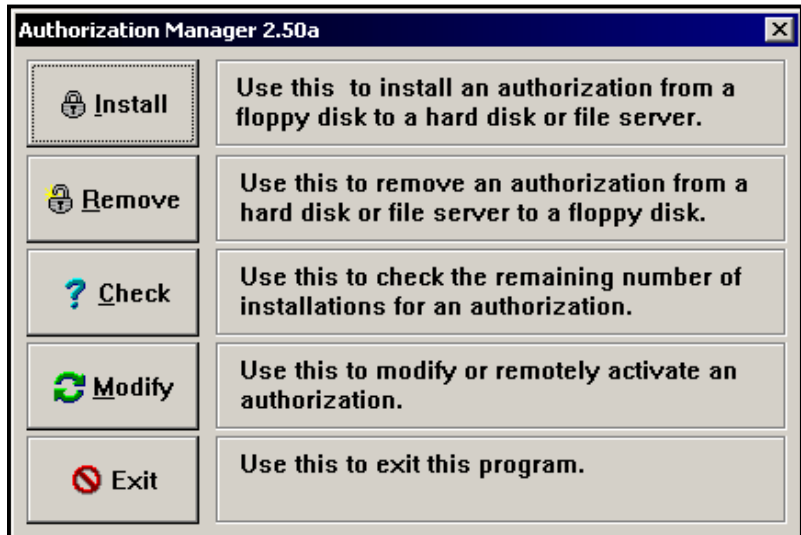
7. The Authorization Manager brings you back to the Menu, if you have no other functions to perform click **Exit**.



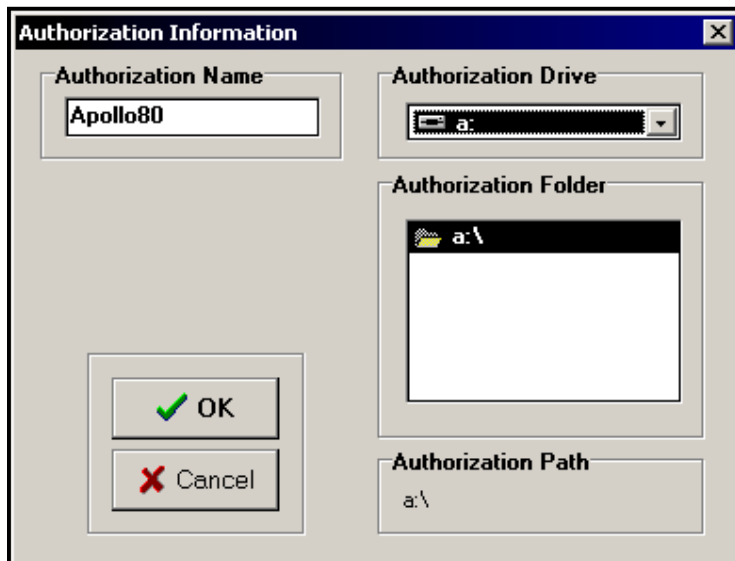

## Check Copy Protection

1. Insert the Copy Protection diskette into the floppy drive.
2. Click **Check** from the Authorization Manager Menu.



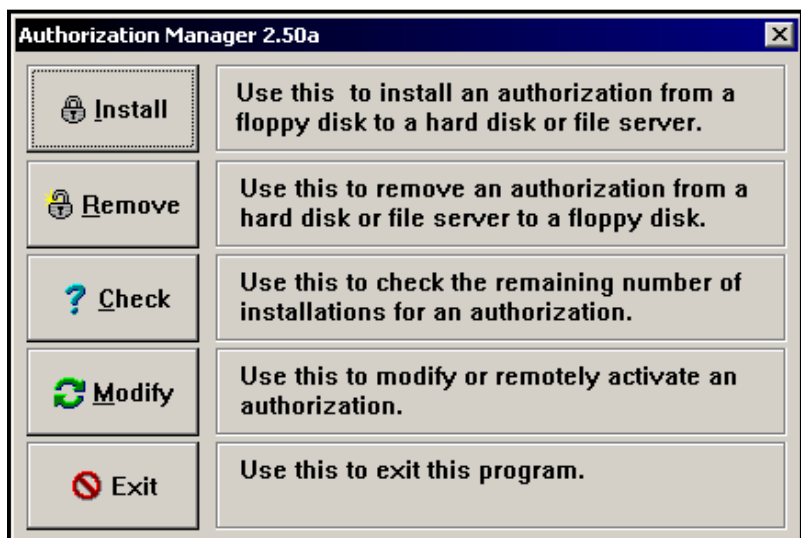
3. **Authorization Name** If the Authorization Name field is blank enter *Apollo80*.

4. **Authorization Drive:** This is the floppy drive where the Copy Protection diskette is located. Drop the list box down and select your floppy drive. If all information is correct, click **OK**.
  5. After the **Remaining Installations** has been displayed, click **OK**.



6. The Authorization Manager brings you back to the Menu, if you have no other functions to perform, click **Exit**.

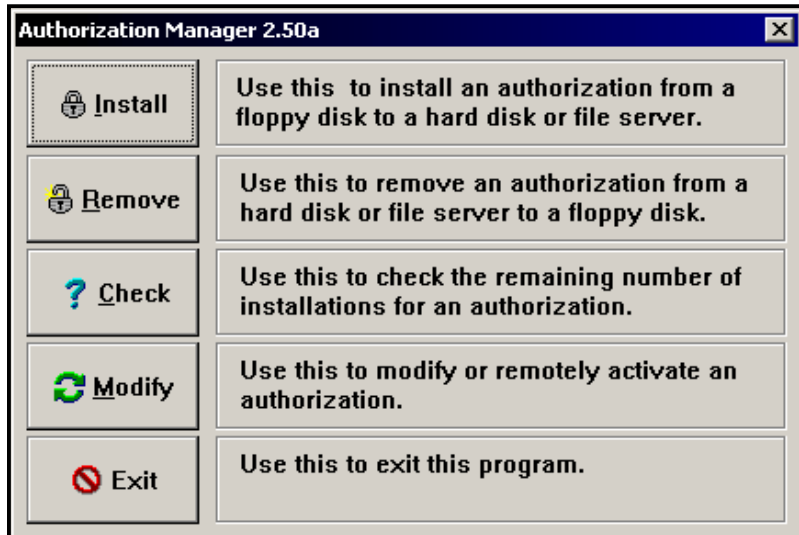

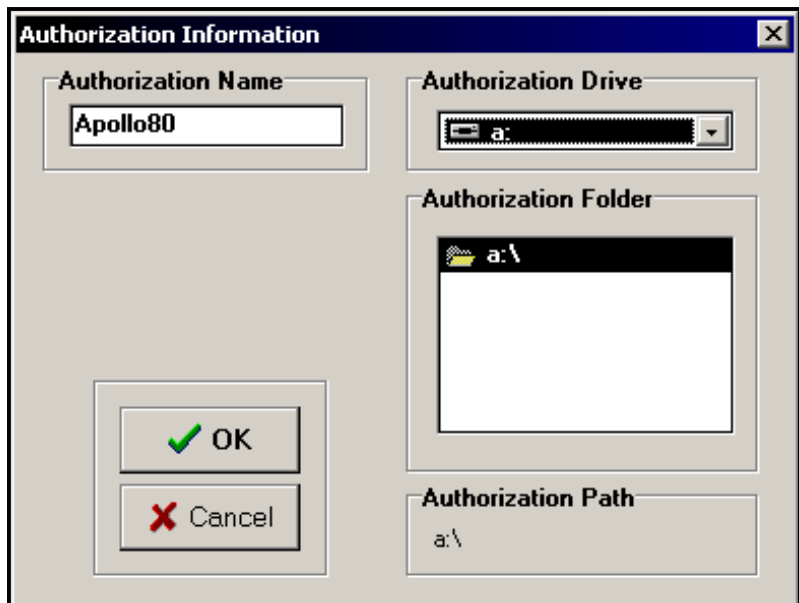
## Modify Copy Protection

**NOTE:** You will only perform this function instructed by an IRI Technical Support Representative

1. Insert the Copy Protection diskette into the floppy drive.
2. Click **Modify** from the Authorization Manager Menu.



3. **Authorization Name:** If the Authorization Name field is blank enter *Apollo80*.



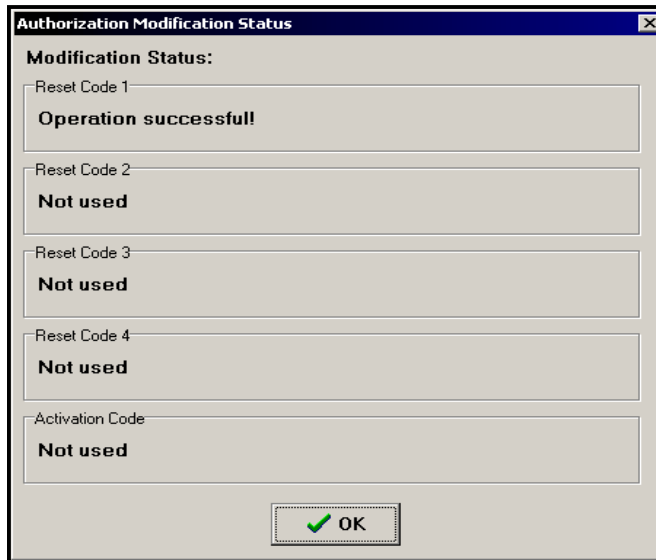
4. **Authorization Drive:** This is the floppy drive where the Copy Protection diskette is located. Drop the list box down and select your floppy drive. If all the information is correct, click **OK**.
5. The **Code Entry** screen appears. Provide the IRI Technical Support Representative with the 6-digit User Code listed.
6. Technical Support will in turn provide a 9-digit code that will be entered into **Reset Code 1** box, click **Modify**.

**NOTE:** The Pound signs # replace the actual numbers will appear as you type them.

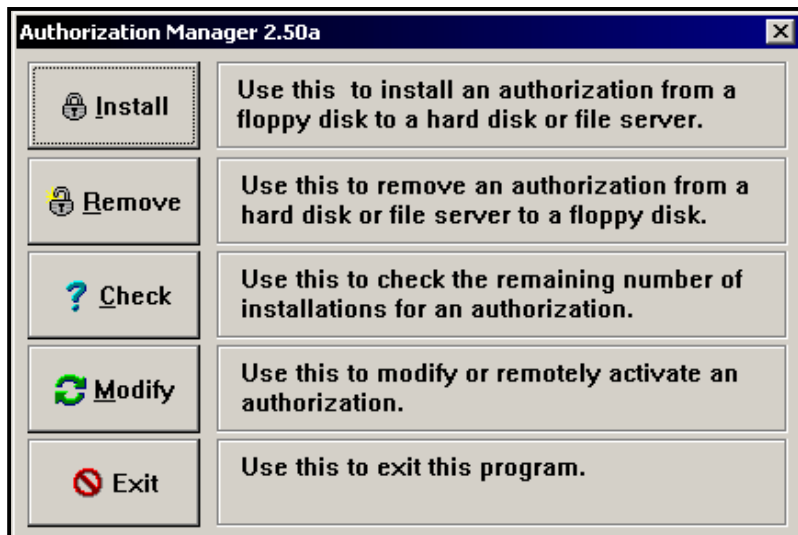
